

FINES

The following activities are in violation of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act M.G.L. c. 131, §40 and the Town of Plymouth Wetlands Protection Bylaw, Article 27, §11. Non-compliance with the requirements stated herein is punishable by fines of not more than \$25,000 or by imprisonment for not more than two years or both, as provided under M.G.L. c. 131, §40; and fines of not more than \$ 50.00 per day as provided under the Town of Plymouth Wetlands protection Bylaw, Article 27, §11. Each day and provision of the bylaw or regulations violated shall constitute a separate offense.

The removal, filling, dredging, altering of a resource area or their buffer zones and construction within 100-feet of a resource area without a permit from the conservation Commission is a violation of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. c. 131 s. 40 and Regulations 310 CMR 10.00 et seq., and Plymouth's Wetlands Protection Bylaw, Article 27 s. 4 and Regulations s. 3 (B) (1), (2).

 (2) If you desire to contest this matter in a noncriminal proceeding, you may do so by making a written request to the above CLERK-MAGISTRATE for a hearing. A determination by a Judge or Clerk-Magistrate will operate as a final disposition, with no resulting criminal record, provided any fine imposed by that officer is paid within the time specified.
 (3) If you fail to pay the above fine or to appear as specified, a criminal complaint may be issued against you.
