

OVERLOOK CLUBHOUSE POLICY

TITLE: Charitable Organizations

The decision as to which charities will be allowed in the Clubhouse will be made by the Advisory Committee and the HOA Board of Directors. Promotion of all charitable appeals in the Overlook Clubhouse must be coordinated by the Lifestyle Director.

Promotion of approved charities to the community via the Great Island email will only be done through the Lifestyle Director. The time a charity can be promoted will be 3 weeks or less as determined by the HOA Board of Directors. This promotion could include the Overlook Overview and/or monthly newsletter. The content of any poster or flyer promoting an approved charity, as well as placement within the Clubhouse, must be approved by the Lifestyle Director. Distribution of flyers and promotional materials to residents' homes is not permitted.

Individuals may promote a charity on their own accord without pre-approval. Promotion of these charities; however, must not involve the use of any Great Island HOA facility.
